Happy New Year everybody...and hope everyone had a safe and pleasant holiday season. Every 1st Wednesday of the month will be an in-person meeting at Merrill Gardens and every 3rd Wednesday of the month will be an online competition. *Note: there are a few exceptions throughout the year.*

Dues pay for our expenses, such as fees for competition judges, awards, website costs, mailing & printing fees, and other things. We charge dues annually, by calendar year.

Club dues are \$30.00 per year per person, \$45.00 per couple or \$45.00 per family. Full- time students are \$15.00 per year. An additional annual \$20.00 competition entry fee is charged for each member who wishes to compete during the year. You must pay by the end of February in order to continue to compete.

Jan 28th (Sat 9:45a - 8pm?) - Day tripping to the Getty Villa in Pacific Palisades

Thank you, Alan, for suggesting this field trip! Meet at Panera Bread off Betteravia and College in Santa Maria (540 E Betteravia Rd). We will form carpools there (if you are vaccinated) as it is a long drive ahead of us, about 150 miles one-way, and parking at the Villa is \$20 per car. We will have a break at the Gaviota rest stop and plan to be at the Villa for lunch at 1pm before exploring the Villa for the afternoon. Leave about 4pm for home.

- Bring a picnic lunch or buy lunch there at the Villa Café (menu/ordering is online)

SMCC FIELD TRIP TO THE SALTON SEA AND ANZA BORREGO DESERT STATE PAK February 20-26, 2023

Join us for an exploration of desert weirdness, flora and fauna, and landscapes big and small at the Salton Sea and Anza-Borrego Desert State Park. We will photograph desert gardens, beautiful wildflowers (hopefully!), slot canyons and rugged landscapes at Anza-Borrego. At the Salton Sea, migrating birds might be in attendance, and for sure there will be the desert "Artscape's" to photograph there.

**Feb 20 – Early Bird Departure Option, overnight at Joshua Tree Instead of driving for 6 hours+ in one day, drive 300 miles to Joshua Tree and have an evening and morning there before scooting to the Sea.

Feb 21 (afternoon) - 23 (morning) Around the Salton Sea (2 days)

Lodging at Candice's Vacation Home Rentals at Glamis North Hot Springs Resort (10595 Hot Mineral Spa Road, Niland, CA 92257). Meet up about 3pm there and get settled. Share 2–3-bedroom vacation home(s) (\$50 per person for both nights) and RV parking (free).
